## **Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board**

### **ITEM # 17-04**

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for Carmacks Hotel Ltd., doing business as Carmacks Hotel for: a new Room Service 24-hour licence; an extension of hours to all licences from 9am to 2am; a change to the point of sale location for the Off Premises Beer/Wine Licence to the General Store; and a catering off endorsement attached to the Food Primary Restricted Licence, providing that all the requirements of the Liquor Act and Regulations have been met.

Condition: A licensed establishment holding an Off Premises Licence must be open for business for a period of four (4) consecutive hours during the period of time specified on the Liquor Primary and/or Food Primary license(s) held by the establishment.

The Yukon Liquor Board approves in principle the addition of a deck, providing that all the requirements of the Liquor Act and Regulations have been met.
