## **Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board**

### **ITEM # 17-13**

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application for Northern Vision Development Corporation doing business as Best Western Gold Rush Inn; for dual licensing with the addition of a Food Primary – All Liquor licence, and extension of hours for liquor service for both licences, providing that all the requirements of the Liquor Act and Regulations have been met.

Conditions:

Food Primary – All Liquor Licence 9:00am – 2:00pm

Condition 1: inside capacity: 84.

Liquor Primary – All Liquor Licence 2:00pm – 2:00am

Condition 1: inside capacity: 84.

Off Premises Liquor Licence 9:00am – 2:00am

Condition 1: Liquor products to be sold from Gold Pan Saloon lounge service counter only.

Condition 2: Operates in conjunction with Food Primary – All Liquor Licence from 9:00am – 2:00pm.

Condition 3: Operates in conjunction with Liquor Primary – All Liquor Licence from 2:00pm – 2:00am.

Condition 4: A licensed establishment holding an Off Premises Licence must be open for business for a period of four (4) consecutive hours during the period of time specified on the Liquor Primary and/or Food Primary licence(s) held by the establishment.

Room Service Licence (no change to hours)

Condition 1: Operates in conjunction with Food Primary – All Liquor Licence.

Condition 2: Operates in conjunction with Liquor Primary – All Liquor Licence.

Condition 3: Room Service liquor to be provided from hotel to bona fide guests only.

Special Licence (Town Hall Banquet Room) 9:00am – 2:00am

Condition 1: Inside capacity: 290; 260 with dance floor in use.

Condition 2: This licence authorizes the licensee to dispense and serve liquor with or without food to guests at social functions.

Special Licence (General Store Banquet Room) 9:00am – 2:00am

Condition 1: Inside capacity: 82.

Condition 2: This licence authorizes the licensee to dispense and serve liquor with or without food to guests at social functions.

David Branigan to be added as named manager on all licences held.
