Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board

ITEM # 17-07

The Yukon Liquor Board approves in principle the application for Winterlong Brewing Co. Ltd., doing business as Winterlong Brewing Co., for the addition of a patio connected to Liquor Manufacturer-Retail Brewery Licence providing that all the requirements of the Liquor Act and Regulations have been met.

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the cancelation of the Liquor Primary-All Liquor Licence.

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the following changes to the Special Conditions of the Liquor Manufacturer Retail-Brewery Licence:

1. This licence allows for the retail sale of beer and beer products manufactured on-site by Winterlong Brewing Co., for on and off premises consumption within the tasting area space.
2. The holder of this licence may provide liquor samples of up to 59.6ml (2oz) for each product available per person of legal age to consume free of charge. The sample tastings shall be distributed in the licensed area.
3. Minors may be in the licensed area if accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
4. Seating capacity inside remains 55.
5. On site consumption is to be served from the brewery service counter.
