Red Wine

Portugal

Borges Quinta De São Simão Da Aguieira #489344 750ml \$19.55

Intense and fruity, with complex red fruit and floral aromas. This 87 point wine (Wine Enthusiast and Wine Advocate magazines) has firm, ripe tannins and a persistent fruity finish.



France

Chateâu St. Martin

de la Garrigue Bronzinelle #194654 750 ml \$23.60

The Bronzinelle sources its Carignan from old vines, which make up 19% of the wine, Syrah comprises 42%, Mourvèdre 13% and Grenache 26%. This is a full-bodied, spicy rich wine. Pair with grilled meats, stuffed vegetables or cheese. Lamb especially will benefit from its rich spicy character.



Spain

Leceranas Evohé Garnacha #664367 750 ml \$19.60

Garnacha is the king of reds in Spain – the country's most widely planted red grape. There is no oak treatment, and no bottle aging on this red, resulting in a vibrant and fruit forward wine, with ripe and rich raspberry, violet and pepper aromas. The palate is fresh and tannins are light and smooth, buoyed by cherry, red currants, anise, dark floral and kirsch flavours. If you want to try a historically evocative Garnacha, this is it. Savor with pork tenderloin, or grill up smoked Chorizo alongside local potatoes for a little Patatas Con Chorizo.



Torres Celeste Ribera Del Duero #384040 750 ml \$27.00

Since Torres launched Celeste a few years ago, the wine has gotten better and better ... This is textbook Ribera; it has smoothness and size along with intriguing black cherry, plum, herbs, tea and tobacco. A bottling for pretty much any wine lover. Pairs with roast chicken or pork, sausages or stew.

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Spain

Torres Don Miguel Gran Coronas
Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva

#36483 750 ml \$20.80

Lovely ruby red with a delicate fading amber rim. Wispy smoke and sandy nose at first are joined by subtle notes of strawberry jam. Lovely cedary, leafy, thymey nuances develop. Voluptuous entry with a gorgeously sweet, resolved entry featuring ripe red fruits with good supporting acidity. Some sweet red apple high tones over juicy sour cherry on the midpalate with cedar and earth leading to a lithe finish. Recommended accompanying with barbequed red meats.



White Wine

Germany

Dr. Loosen Villa Wolf Riesling - Pfalz

#876185 750 ml \$19.20

A very inviting and refreshing dry Riesling. Delivering classic characteristics of juicy peach, ripe pear, melon, with firm but subtle mineral notes. Not overly austere, but still offers fresh and tangy acidity throughout the finish.



France

Pfaffenheim Grand Cru Steinert
Gewurztraminer

#615898 750 ml \$36.60

An intense golden yellow, with a complex nose of citrus marmalade, pear and strawberry, with a touch of banana in the mouth. Well-balanced with good acidity and a long finish. Excellent with Asian food!



Drouhin Reserve de Vaudon Chablis

#519686 750 ml \$31.10

An elegant wine. Brilliant colour, with hints of green. Typical Chablis nose, where aromas of citrus (lemon) fern and even salty sensations predominate. On the palate: vigorous and lively, but in a soft mode. A lot of finesse and balance.



Spain

Torres Viña Esmeralda Moscatel

#165316 750 ml \$16.70

Although mainly Moscatel, Viña Esmeralda is dominated by the fragrance and spice of the Gewürztraminer. Aromas of honeysuckle, ripe pear and custard apple intermingle with sweet vanilla spice. Fresh and lively on the palate with an aromatic richness that finishes with nuances of cinnamon and cloves. Sublime served with seafood, fish and especially paté, this is a great aperitif.



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
