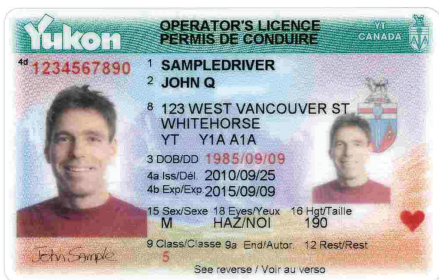


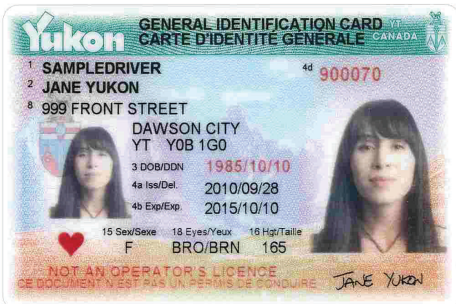

Yukon ID Proofing Guide



New Driver's Licence and New General Identification Card Beginning November 2010

Note: Bar code on the back is for the use of law enforcement ONLY.



At the Door

- Check ID at the door and identify minors before they come in
- Provide an area with adequate lighting where ID can be checked; use a penlight for spot lighting
- Hold the ID in your hands, rather than allowing the patron to flash it at you— if it is in a case or wallet, have them take it out for you
- Take your time and examine the ID closely
- Ask for a second piece of ID or more—the best one is a current credit card

On the ID

- Check the birthdate—are they of age?
- Check the expiry date—is the ID still valid?

Continued...

- Check the photo—is this the person standing in front of you? Especially look at the ears, eyes, mouth and nose, since they are the most likely to be the same no matter how else the person has changed
- Ask for a sample signature to compare to the signature on the photo ID

Asking Questions

- Ask their middle name, and how to spell it
- Ask for specific information on the card such as the address or postal code
- Do their responses sound prompt and sincere?
- How is the person acting—confident or nervous, avoiding eye contact?

Remember, you don't have to accept any piece of ID if you are not sure that they are of age.

ID Blitz Reminder

Targeted inspections, focused on checking ID's for youth who appear to be under 19, will be conducted by Liquor Inspectors, including the RCMP, between **May 9th and May 31, 2011.**

Change in Ownership

If you are planning to sell or lease out your business, you and the person taking over your business should know that the transfer of the liquor licence is required. The new owner (or lessee) is required to complete an application for transfer. It takes time to process an application – possibly up to 30 days. To ensure a timely transfer, please advise us well in advance. Any substantial change in the structure of a corporation (sale, assignment or transfer of shares) also requires an application to the Liquor Corporation for a licence transfer. Your liquor licence is only valid if you are in fact the true owner or lessee of the business. If you are unsure about exactly what constitutes a change in ownership or lease arrangements, please contact us.

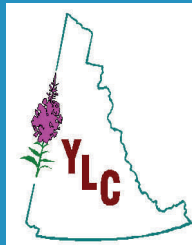
