Liquor Rules During Territorial Elections:

A Territorial election has been called for Tuesday, October 11, 2011.



The *Elections Act* **prohibits the sale and service of liquor** in licensed premises during the hours that the polls are open. Accordingly, Yukon licensees are prohibited from selling or otherwise supplying alcohol between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. that day.

All licensed premises may remain open for food and non-alcoholic beverage services. Those liquor-primary premises who have received specific Board approval to use their premises for breakfast prior to liquor service hours, may continue to serve breakfast during the hours stated on the licence.

Liquor sales may resume after the polls close at 8:00 p.m. and continue until the normal closing time.

The YLC Main Office will be open until 4:00 p.m. on Election Day. Licensees may place liquor orders at the Central Warehouse on Tuesday; however, no orders can be picked up. **All liquor stores will be closed.**



Are You Eligible to Renew?

To be eligible for licence renewal, a premise must be 'operational' for at least three months of the licence year (April 1 through March 31 of the following year). Please contact our Licensing staff at 667-5245 if you are concerned that this requirement may affect your eligibility.

Liquor ID is no longer valid after November 1.

Are you still accepting Yukon Liquor ID as proof of age? Time is running out, they are not valid as of Nov. 1.

Acceptable ID includes:

- Y Drivers Licence with photograph
- Y Government-issued ID card with photograph
- Y Passport
- Y Canadian Citizenship card



Have you notified us?

We would like to remind you that there may be times during the year when we need to hear from you. We rely on you, the licensee, to keep us informed of changes that may affect your licence and your operations. By advising us promptly, it will help us keep your file and licences current and in doing so, meet the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and *Regulations*.

If you plan to make any changes to your licensed premises, that will affect the information endorsed on your licence, or any changes in ownership of your premises, you must notify us, and in some instances receive specific approval.

Changes may include:

- Y new manager and/or addition of manager
- Y ownership (e.g., purchase/sale of premises, sale/transfer of shares, or lease of premises)
- Y licensee name (e.g., change in company name)
- Y structural alterations (renovations, additions)
- Y permanent or temporary additions (bandstand, stage, dance floor, service counter, etc.)
- Y increase or decrease in the number of games
- Y hours of liquor sales

Liquor Service Hours

Just a reminder—all liquor sales and service must end by 2:00 am. And everyone except staff must have left by 2:30 am.

Checking for ID
