Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board

ITEM # 19-04

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application in principle for Jamie Toole and Anne Morgan, operating as Caribou Hotel, for:

1. A Liquor Primary – All Liquor and Off-Premises Liquor License providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.

Condition:

A licensed establishment holding an Off Premises Licence must be open for business for a period of four (4) consecutive hours during the period of time specified on the Liquor Primary and/or Food Primary license(s) held by the establishment.

2. Food Primary and Room Service Licenses providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.
3. Two licensed enclosed decks one adjacent to the dining room and one adjacent to the bar providing that all the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations have been met.
