Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board

ITEM # 18-33

The Yukon Liquor Board approves the application in principle for Cork and Bull Restaurant Inc., operating as Dirty Northern Public House and Miner's Daughter Eatery, for an expansion of the licensed interior area on to the second floor, to the existing Food Primary – All Liquor and Liquor Primary – All Liquor licenses, providing that all the requirements of the Liquor Act and Regulations have been met.

Condition:

Off sales transactions are restricted to the four bar service areas within the licensed premises only.

This decision is based on the application as presented to board, and relevant sections of the *Liquor Act* and Regulations and board policy.
