We'd like to remind you that all Yukon liquor licences **expire at midnight on March 31, 2009**.

Your "**Application for Renewal**" package will be mailed in early January. We greatly appreciate your efforts to return the completed applications, supporting documents and specified fees as soon as possible.

For your convenience you may return all required documents and make your payments at either our Head Office in Whitehorse or the nearest liquor store in communities outside Whitehorse.

Offsales Policy

We would like to remind you of the Board established policy regarding the purchase of offsales liquor from licensed premises.

Customers who wish to purchase alcohol for consumption off-premises must pay for and take possession of the product **immediately prior** to leaving the licensed premises. This means that after buying offsales, the customer may **not** be served additional liquor or be permitted to loiter in or around the service area.

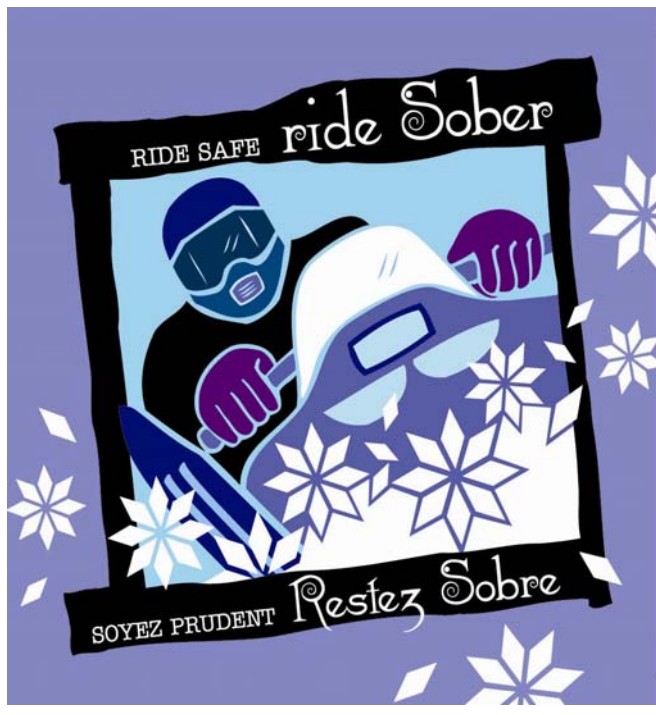

Hot Not Toddy

7 ounces hot tea

1 Tbsp. honey

1 tsp. lemon juice

Grated cinnamon

Ground cloves

Grated nutmeg

Lemon wedge for garnish

Instructions: In an Irish coffee glass pour the honey, lemon and spices. Top with hot, brewed tea. Stir. Garnish with lemon wedge.



Cajun Coffee

3 cups Hot Strong Coffee

6 Tablespoons Molasses

6 Tablespoons Dark Rum

Optional: Whipped Cream, Nutmeg (freshly ground)

Instructions: Combine coffee and molasses in a saucepan. Heat, stirring until molasses is dissolved and coffee is very hot. Do NOT allow to boil. If desired place 1 Tablespoon rum in each mug. Add coffee. Top with whipped cream; sprinkle with nutmeg. Do NOT stir before drinking.
