

Licensee Information Bulletin



Keep us informed

Now that the licence renewal season is virtually wrapped up, we would like to remind you that there may be other times during the year when we'll need to hear from you. We rely on you "the licensee" to keep us informed of changes that may affect your licence and your establishment's operations. By advising us promptly, it will help us keep your file and licenses current and in doing so, meet the requirements of the *Liquor Act* and *Regulations*.

If you plan to make any changes in your licensed premises that will affect the information endorsed on your licence, you must notify us, and in some instances receive specific approval.

Changes may involve:

- new manager and/or addition of manager
- structural alterations (renovations, additions)
- permanent or temporary additions (bandstand, stage, dance floor, service counter, etc.)
- increase or decrease in the number of games
- licensee name (ie. change in company name)
- ownership (ie. purchase/sale of premises, sale/transfer of shares, or lease of premises)
- hours of liquor sales

REMINDER!

FOOD MUST BE AVAILABLE THROUGHOUT THE HOURS OF LIQUOR SERVICE IN A BAR OR A RESTAURANT.

Barring procedure

If you or your staff find a person in your premises that is intoxicated, riotous, noisy, quarrelsome, violent, disorderly, verbally abusive, profane, or acting in a manner that contravenes any other statute or bylaw, this person must leave the premises immediately after being requested to do so. You may also prohibit this person from entering your premises for a further specified time. This is called "barring".

If you "bar" a person for more than an evening, you must notify this person in writing, as soon as possible, stating when the barring took effect, the reason for the barring, the specific date of when the barring ends, and the person's right to appeal the barring order to the Yukon Liquor Board of Directors. A copy of the written notification or barring order must be forwarded to both the Yukon Liquor Corporation and the local RCMP.

The length of the "barring" will depend upon the severity of the incident.

If a person does not leave the premises after being requested to do so or violates a barring order, you or your staff may call the RCMP and have the person charged for "refusing to leave a licensed premises".

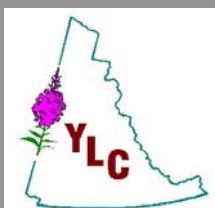
