

## **Meeting Date – July 20, 2011**

### **Decision of the Yukon Liquor Board**

#### **ITEM #11-26**

The Yukon Liquor Board (the “Board”) met on July 20, 2011 to consider the application for liquor licences by TND Motor Hotel (Margie Etzel and Timothy Moon) (the Applicant).

The Board considered the laws, regulations and policies as were in effect on July 20, 2011 which specifically relate, and are relevant, to the application. There was one objector, W. Besner of Ross River.

Both the applicant, represented by Ms. Etzel and the objector were present via telephone for the meeting.

The Yukon Liquor Corporation also provided a report of past infractions, as per sec. 37 of the Yukon Liquor Act, to the Board as part of the application documentation.

The Board determined, pursuant to sections 37(i) and 37(j) of the Act, and tab 5 of the Board policy manual the the applicant(s) were “unfit” persons as defined in the Act and Policy.

Based on the report of infractions and the applicant’s insistence that “she did a good job” the application for a Food Primary licence is denied.

As a result the Off Premises application cannot be considered.
