## YUKON BREWING DISCOVERY ALE 6/341ML

Discovery Ale was the beer on brew sheet number one, back in early 1997. The beer is a honey pale ale, but we didn't use just any old honey. Since fireweed is the official flower of the Yukon, we thought that it would be only right if the first brew should use fireweed honey, which results in a different flavor from other honey beers. Discovery Ale is coppery in color, and finishes dry on the tongue. Code #777117 \$12.00

## WISERS SPECIAL BLEND 375ML

Beefy with sharpening touches of rye and other slightly fruity citrus notes. Very busy mouth arrival with a complex array of corn on the cob and then much cleaner small grain notes. Good weight to the oiliness which never goes over the top. A brief spice flies past, and an early vanilla oak attack. Code # 3517 \$11.80



## VILLA TERESA ORGANIC PROSECCO 750ML

Prosecco is Italy's answer to refreshing, well-made sparkling wine at a reasonable price. Typically from the Veneto region, this 100% Prosecco is different since it's also 100% organic. Straw in color with small bubbles followed by a touch of pear and melon in the aroma. This is crisp and clean with nice acidity and has a refreshing dry finish. Only organic agriculture was used in the production of this wine, and traditional vinification methods were employed, contains no pesticides, herbicides or any chemical fertilization and no added sulphites.

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#### SLJIVOVICA OLD PLUM BRANDY 750ML

Slivovitz is a pure, natural brandy made by special fermentation and distillation of the finest ripe blue plums grown in the rich soil of the Adriatic Coast, the second largest plum-growing area in the world. "Sljovovica" is the common name for Croatian plum brandy from former Yugoslavia. Traditionally this spirit is double-distilled and has been famous since the Middle Ages. The fruit comes from trees never less than 20 years old and the mash is fermented for three months in large 2,000 gallon tanks. After a second distillation it is matured in specially treated 500-gallon oak casks for a minimum of 2 years. Code #296764 \$30.20



#### SAINT VIVANT VSOP ARMAGNAC 750ML

St. Vivant Armagnac is a smooth, high quality brandy. Made in France, it has a full flavor and a rich tradition that dates back to 1559 when St. Vivant de la Salle produced the first bottle of Armagnac Brandy. The famous "crooked bottle" recalls the original bottles used by St. Vivant. Code #73080 \$67.95

#### BALVENIE DOUBLEWOOD 12YR 750ML

The Balvenie Doublewood Single Malt Scotch Whisky is a 12 year old single malt which gains its distinctive character from being matured in two woods. During its period of maturation The Balvenie Doublewood is transferred from a traditional oak whisky cask to a first fill Spanish oak sherry cask. Each stage lends different qualities to the resulting single malt - the traditional casks, having previously held bourbon, soften and add character, whilst the sherry wood brings depth and fullness of flavor. #### LAPHROAIG 10YR OLD 750ML

Laphroaig 10 Year Old is an all-malt Scotch Whisky from the remote island of Islay in the Western Isles of Scotland. Laphroaig, pronounced "La-froyg", is a Gaelic word meaning "the beautiful hollow by the broad bay". In making Laphroaig, malted barley is dried over a peat fire. The smoke from this peat, found only on Islay, gives Laphroaig its particularly rich flavor. Laphroaig is best savored neat, or with a little cool water. Roll it around on your tongue. Release the pungent, earthy aroma of blue peat smoke, the sweet nuttiness of the barley, the delicate heathery perfume of Islay's streams. It is as unique as the island itself. Code #135210 \$53.00

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
