Smoke Free Places Act



Effective October, YLC Liquor Inspectors will be responsible for reporting the following violations, if observed in licensed premises, under the *Smoke Free Places Act*:

- Persons smoking
- Ashtrays present
- Tobacco products displayed

If such violations are noted, a report will be completed and a copy will be provided to the person in charge. The report will be forwarded to Health & Social Services who will be responsible for any further action.

A licensed premises may include an outside area such as a licensed deck or patio. Please check your liquor licence for inside/outside seating areas.

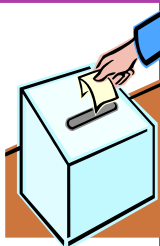
Tip of the Month

Municipal/Civic Elections:

Civic elections will take place on October 15, 2009. During civic elections, licensed premises may remain open for liquor sales during the hours specified on the liquor licence. All YLC offices and stores will also be open for full service.



Are You Eligible to Renew?

To be eligible for licence renewal, a premise must be 'operational' for at least three months of the licence year (April 1 through March 31 of the following year). Please contact our Licensing & Development staff at 667-5245 if you are concerned that this requirement may affect your eligibility.

Have you notified us?

We would like to remind you that there may be times during the year when we need to hear from you. We rely on you, the licensee, to keep us informed of changes that may affect your licence and your operations. By advising us promptly, it will help us keep your file and licences current and in doing so, meet the requirements of the *Liquor Act and Regulations*.

If you plan to make any changes to your licensed premises, that will affect the information endorsed on your licence, or any changes in ownership of your premises, you must notify us, and in some instances receive specific approval.

Changes may include:

- new manager and/or addition of manager
- ownership (e.g., purchase/sale of premises, sale/transfer of shares, or lease of premises)
- licensee name (e.g., change in company name)
- structural alterations (renovations, additions)
- permanent or temporary additions (bandstand, stage, dance floor, service counter, etc.)
- increase or decrease in the number of games
- hours of liquor sales

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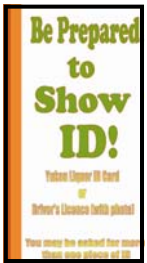
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ID Blitz

Checking for ID

Although the Blitz has ended you should continue to check for ID. One of the best ways to keep minors out of your premises is to routinely check the ID of all patrons who appear to be under 25 years old. Sometimes it's hard to tell if someone is under 19. It's a judgement call based on your experience with young people. If you are not sure...**ASK!** It's the only way to ensure you are meeting your legal obligations.



Burnt Raven
