COMING SOON – NEW ID!

New Yukon driver licences and general identification cards will soon be available. The more secure format will help ensure that minors do not illegally purchase or consume liquor, or enter age-restricted premises.

The Yukon Liquor Corporation will stop producing the current Liquor ID's once the new cards are available. However, the older format liquor ID will remain valid for a period of time, should you choose to accept it as proof of age.

We will provide you with information in advance of the new ID being issued, to explain the security features and how to verify the ID. We are revising our pamphlet on checking ID, and we will incorporate the new card formats into the BARS course.

The Yukon Liquor Board has granted conditional approval providing that all requirements of the *Liquor Act and Regulations* have been met to:

CONSENT OF PARENT FORM

If you plan to have minors working in your premises, or you already employ a minor, you must have a completed parental consent form in the licensed premises and it must be made available to the Liquor Inspectors, upon request.

The *Liquor Act and Regulations* state:

Minors are allowed to deliver liquor in food-primary (restaurant/dining room) premises, if they are at least 16, have written parental consent, and are supervised by the adult manager of the premises. This does not include opening, pouring, or mixing of alcoholic beverages.

Minors are allowed to enter a liquor-primary (bar) premises for limited work purposes or performing, if they are at least 16, have written parental consent, and are supervised by the adult manager of the premises. This does not include working as a server or bartender.

Barring Procedure

If you or your staff find a person in your premises that is intoxicated, riotous, noisy, quarrelsome, violent, disorderly, verbally abusive, profane, or acting in a manner that contravenes any other statute or bylaw, this person must leave the premises immediately after being requested to do so. You may also prohibit this person from entering your premises for a further specified time. This is called "barring".

If you "bar" a person for more than an evening, you must notify this person in writing, as soon as possible, stating when the barring took effect, the reason for the barring, the specific date when the barring ends, and the person's right to appeal the barring order to the Yukon Liquor Board. A copy of the written notification or barring order must be forwarded to both the Yukon Liquor Corporation and the local RCMP.

The length of the "barring" will depend upon the severity of the incident.

If a person does not leave the premises after being requested to do so or violates a barring order, you or your staff may call the RCMP and have the person charged for "refusing to leave a licensed premises".

This procedure is set out in Section 9(2) and 9(3) of the Liquor Regulations and Tab 1 of the Yukon Liquor Board Policy Manual. If you have any questions, please contact the Licensing Branch at 667-5245.
